## High School Test Credit Equivalencies and GER Completion - Fall 2023

## General AP Policy

Undergraduate students admitted to Emory University as students in Emory College of Arts and Sciences (ECAS) or Oxford College may receive up to 12 credit hours towards hours required for graduation through acceptable Advanced Placement (AP) scores, International Baccalaureate (IB) scores, or other internationally recognized testing schemes (e.g. A-levels, French Baccalaureate). Students with more than four acceptable test scores may receive a non-credit-bearing course waiver for each additional test.

Unless otherwise stated, each course will carry 3 credit hours required for graduation.

## First-Year Writing Requirement

The following test credit courses satisfy the First-Year Writing Requirement.

## Notes

- Where two exams are offered in one field, credit will be offered for one but not both exams.
- Students who take both the AP and IB tests for the same course are eligible to have only one test posted for the course.
- For IB courses, credit is awarded for Higher Level exams only.


## Intercultural Communication

The following test credit courses may satisfy one of two required Intercultural Communication (IC) courses. Note that to complete the IC requirement, students must complete one additional language course in the same language as their test credit at Emory. If a student begins a new language at Emory, they will be required to complete a second sequential course to complete the GER area.

## Notes

- For IB courses, credit is awarded for Higher Level exams only.
- Students who take both the AP and IB tests for the same course are eligible to have only one test posted for the course.
- For all IB language courses, it must be determined whether or not the student took the IB course in her or his native language. Credit will normally be given only for Group 2 Language Acquisition (Language B) courses; however, students who complete Group 1 Studies in Language \& Literature (Language A) courses outside their native language may also receive credit.
- Language course equivalents are for the purpose of awarding credit only and do not indicate a student's level of placement in a language. Students taking IB language exams may be placed in a higher language course and should take the relevant placement test to determine the appropriate course to take.
- A student may receive credit for only one test in a particular language, either in Group 1 or Group 2.
- Emory University may accept language exams other than those here listed upon petition.


## Other Test Credits Providing Credit on the Emory Transcript.

Please note that if a course is not listed below, no Emory credit will be awarded for that test. Please note that while these courses have equivalents at Emory, no General Education Requirements will be satisfied by these courses.
