Boren Awards	- US citizenship required - For language study in world regions that are critical to US security interests - Interest in public service - Study abroad program of one academic year  borenawards.org	Application Deadline: Late Jan.

Freeman-ASIA Award	- US citizenship or permanent residency - Study Abroad in East or Southeast Asia - Demonstrates verifiable financial need.  iie.org/Programs/Freeman-ASIA	Application Deadline: Mid-Mar.
Bridging Scholarships for study in Japan	- US citizenship - Study abroad in Japan for at least 3 months  aatj.org/studyabroad/japan-bridging-scholarships	Spring Application Deadline: Oct. Fall or Academic Year Deadline: Apr.
Toshizo Watanabe Study Abroad Scholarship	- US citizenship or permanent residency - Study Abroad in Japan  usjapanCouncil.org/watanabe_scholarship	Application Deadline: See website

General Information about Finances and Education Abroad

- Semester programs: **All** student aid (grants, scholarships, loans) awarded for the semester **will** be applied towards the education abroad billable charges.
- Summer programs: The summer education abroad grant will be determined based on demonstrated need and is program specific. Summer financial aid can be drastically different from semester aid.
- Additional expenses could be but are not limited to: program fees, housing, additional meals, personal expenses in country, visa costs, and airfare.
