**2:30 ceremony:** Students in Natural Sciences, Mathematics, Anthropology, and the Center for the Study of Human Health will be recognized.

**Departments:** Anthropology, Biology, Chemistry, Computer Science, Environmental Sciences, Human Health, Mathematics, Neuroscience & Behavioral Biology, and Physics

**5:30 ceremony:** Students in Arts, Humanities, and Social Sciences will be recognized.

**Departments:** African American Studies, African Studies, Ancient Mediterranean Studies, Art History, Classics, Comparative Literature, Creative Writing, Dance and Movement Studies Program, Economics, English, Film and Media, French & Italian, History, Institute for the Liberal Arts (ILA), Linguistics, Music, Philosophy, Playwriting, Political Science, Psychology, Psychology & Linguistics, Quantitative Theory and Methods, Religion, Russian, Eastern European, and Eurasian Studies, Sociology, Spanish & Portuguese, Theater, and Women's, Gender, and Sexuality Studies

Both ceremonies will require all guests to have tickets. Children under three will be considered lap babies and will not need a ticket. You will receive two tickets via Tassel when you register for the Honors Ceremony. Unfortunately, we cannot offer additional tickets. The Honors Ceremony typically runs 1.5 hours, so we recommend you and your guests plan to be on campus for about 2- 2 1/2 hours. Please plan to arrive on campus 30-45 minutes before the start of your ceremony and find your seat. You will be seated in alphabetical order by last name with your classmates. This ensures you are appropriately seated to walk across the stage as your name is called. Instructions will be emailed to participants the week of the Honors Ceremony.
